Frankie Raymond z"l, who founded the Shul in the memory of his dear son Rabbi Eyal Raymond z"l who tragically passed away at the young age of 29, always considered learning to be a vital part of what we do at Tiferet Eyal and we have continued that tradition throughout our history. When Covid restrictions hit we moved shiurim online via Zoom and we still continue our Tuesday night series on Zoom where we regularly get around 50 tuning in from various shuls in North London to listen to Dayan Danny Kada presenting interesting contemporary topics.

In Shul Learning

We were able to resume face to face learning in Shul this year and Dayan Danny taught Derech Hashem each Monday and Thursday in short half hour sessions, covering topics such as God, Providence, and Free Will. The completion of the course in August was marked with a Siyyum. A weekly Halacha shiur was added mid year on Thursdays following Arvit. We have now started a new series "Daat Tevunot - Knowing God's Plan" which is The Precise System through which God directs Every Aspect of Existence based on the Ramhal's next book.
